

# Swiss Hiking Night June 27-28, 2026

## Full Moon Night Hike to the Jazzilücke

### 🌟 An Unforgettable Nature Experience

Experience the magic of the mountains at night: In the light of the full moon, this impressive tour leads through wild high valleys, over historic passes, and to a spectacular highlight – sunrise at the Jazzilücke with an unobstructed view to the east.

### 🏠 Tour Description

From Saas-Almagell, the path leads up to Furggstalden and further into the remote Furggtal. The trail runs pleasantly along the valley floor, allowing for a peaceful immersion into the nocturnal mountain world. At the Antronapass, you reach the Swiss-Italian border. The path continues over extensive rock slabs, ascending further – at times exposed and secured with handrails – to the Jazzilücke. Surefootedness and a head for heights are absolutely essential here. With a bit of luck, you may spot ibex or chamois along the way, which appear in the silence of the night and early morning.

After about **5½ hours** of pure hiking time, we reach the highlight of the tour:

🌅 **Sunrise at the Jazzilücke** – an unforgettable moment high above the Alps. Beyond the Jazzilücke, the pristine Ofental valley opens up. The path leads through rocky slopes and later through a wide valley floor with a rushing stream down to the Mattmark.

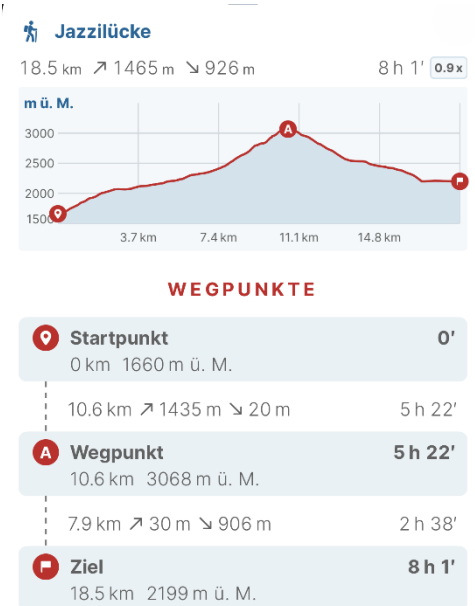
- 22:30 Welcome at Hotel Bar Kristall-Saphir

**Equipment:** Equipment: High alpine, very warm clothing, gloves, hat, rain protection, sturdy mountain boots with Vibram soles, headlamp
